Purpose

SBSI was established in honour of Seyi Bickersteth who served as Senior Partner of KPMG in Nigeria from 2002 to 2016, and Chairman, KPMG Africa from 2014 to 2016. He was the Country Managing Partner of Arthur Andersen from 1998 to June 2002, Regional Managing Partner, Andersen Tax Africa from 2018 to 2021, and a non-executive Director of Leadway from January 2017 to March 2021.

Seyi was a man of intelligence, integrity and impact in and outside of the institutions he worked with. Aside from his God-given intellect and determination, Seyi rose from a humble and challenging beginning to a man of impact due to the scholarships he received.



In addition to her academic pursuits in Economics, Ozili has a keen interest in Accounting and Management.






